
How and Where it comes from?

Within the **Confucius** way of thinking, **resilience** enbodies many layers of practice, from **internal** to **external**:


Mind & Body Home & Community Society & World



If I could give **resilience** a **transcultural definition**, I would initiate the intellectual conversation from "**identity**".

> Communities (rural and urban) could not be with resilience, if we, as individuals, do not enbody internal resilience within our persoanl life.

Personal resilience is nothing but our indiviual, as well as collective, identities: Who I am? Why I want to be who I am? How could I sustain who I am? How do I interact with others as who I am? How do I integrate with my surrounding environments? In 21st Century, our civilization has rapidly transformed from an agri-rural civilization to an urban civilization Global population trend of the urbanisation: 2008 54% urban population 2075 75% urban population



Within the context of being up-rooted from our land and rural, I proposed the concept of **Agricultual Humanities**

Agricultural humanities refer to agricultural practices, cultivations, and innovations embodying social, environmental and ethical aspects rooted in histories and civilizations.

Agricultural humanities strive to:

(1) to re-connect and re-balance urban and rural through ecological engagements, and

(2) to nurture local pride of the incoming rural young generations.

The successful agricultural humanities embody agri-based economic developments and educations that link between rural towns and urban communities.

The link might be initiated by individuals.





From winter **2011**, **2 students and I** arrived Pinglin Spring **2015**, we have started up **2 tea** realated social enterprises. Spring **2016**, dozens of NTU professors offer multiple courses and workshops that bring hundreds of young people to Pinglin.


