**FIRST GOPOST READING RESPONSE: APRIL 3**

You should all post a first reading response on one of the assigned readings this week, following the general guidelines: choose one reading and identify a particular issue that you'd like to discuss in more detail. In the general guidelines we suggest that you focus on concepts you find unclear, arguments you'd like to reconstruct and assess, and/or questions about the real-world implications of the claims or positions presented. For this post we recommend focusing on this last. For example:

- Do Bartky's or Frye's accounts of oppression capture any aspects of your experience? Do they make sense of the impact that that sex/gender roles and identities have on the opportunities and experience of others you know?
- Can you identify the internalized fear of difference that Lorde so eloquently describes in any aspects of your own experience, your interactions with others, or in interactions you've observed?
