CONSTITUTION OF SERBIA

Article 1

The Republic of Serbia is the state of Serbian people and all other citizens who live in it, founded on the rule of law and social justice, principles of civil democracy, human and minority rights and freedoms, and belonging to the European principles and values.

Article 10

In the Republic of Serbia in official use is the Serbian language and the Cyrillic alphabet. Official use of other languages and alphabets is regulated by law, based on the Constitution.
