Since there was recently a question regarding Kirik, I thought it might be of interest to note this book, just listed by Kozmenko:

Kniga znakomit s zhizn'iu i tvorchestvom vydaiushchegosia russkogo uchenogo i myslitelia XII stoletia Kirika Novgorodtsa (1110 - ne ranee 1156/58). Analiziruiutsia grani darovaniia Kirika v oblasti matematiki, astronomii, kalendare, bogoslovii, filosofii. Delaetsia vyvod, chto myslitel' byl krupnym predstavitelem teologicheskogo ratsionalizma drevnerusskoi religiozno-filosofskoi mysli. Vpervye v odnom izdanii v polnom ob'eme publikuetsia nasledie Kirika Novgorodtsa. (0.855 kg.) ISBN 978-5-7396-0221-3 32.00 /20.65 /24.65

This would appear to be a much expanded version of one Simonov published (in a modest 111 pp) back in 1980. How one can produce 544 pp. on Kirik, given his apparently modest output, is an interesting question which only a reading of this new book will reveal. The fact that it contains the texts though could make it very valuable.
