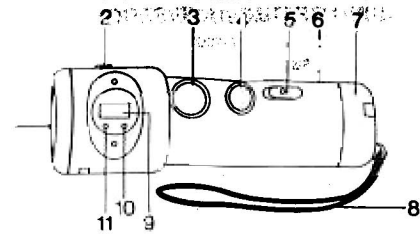




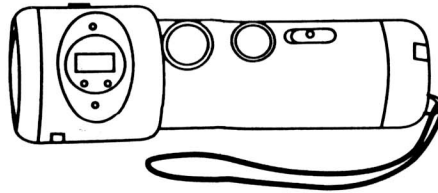
# AM/FM FLASHLIGHT RADIO WITH CLOCK AND SIREN



## LOCATIONS OF CONTROLS

- 1) Light
- 2) Light Selector Switch
- 3) Tuning Control Knob
- 4) Volume Control Knob
- 5) AM/FM/Siren Switch
- 6) Belt Clip
- 7) Battery Cover
- 8) Hand Strap/FM Lead Antenna
- 9) Liquid Crystal Display
- 10) Mode Button
- 11) Set Button

## OPERATING INSTRUCTION

## POWER OPERATION (RADIO)

This unit is designed to operate with DC 3V (two "C" size batteries.) Batteries not included.

Open the Battery Cover Install two "C" size batteries, observing the battery polarity (+ and -).

**NOTE:** WEAK OR DEAD BATTERIES MAY SWELL AND LEAK. TO AVOID DAMAGE TO THE UNIT, REMOVE THE BATTERIES WHEN THE UNIT IS TO BE STORED FOR A LONG PERIOD OF TIME OR IF THE BATTERIES BECOME WEAK.

## RADIO LISTENING

1. Turn ON-OFF volume control to ON position.
2. Set the selector to either AM or FM BAND. Rotate the tuning knob until the desired station is selected.
3. Adjust the volume control to the desired listening level.

*No kidding, - that's what it is!*

## LIGHT

This unit can be used as a flash light by setting the light Selector Switch to ON position. Set the Selector Switch to OFF position to switch off the light.

## EMERGENCY SIREN / BLINKING LIGHT

You can turn on the siren sound by sliding the AM/FM/Siren Selector to Siren position. Next turn volume control to ON position. SLIDE the LIGHT SELECTOR TO OFF position to activate the blinker.

## FUNCTION OF THE CLOCK

Clock operated by individual 1.5V button cell battery. The Display indicates the current time, date and seconds.
