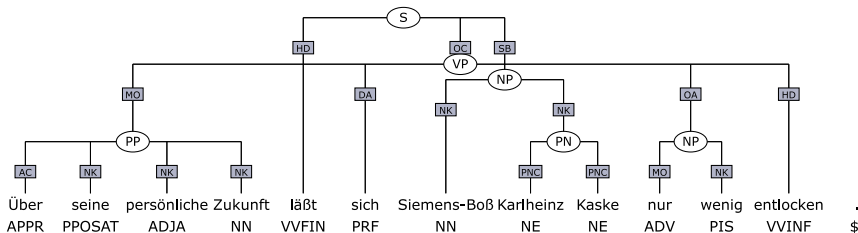

German Word Order

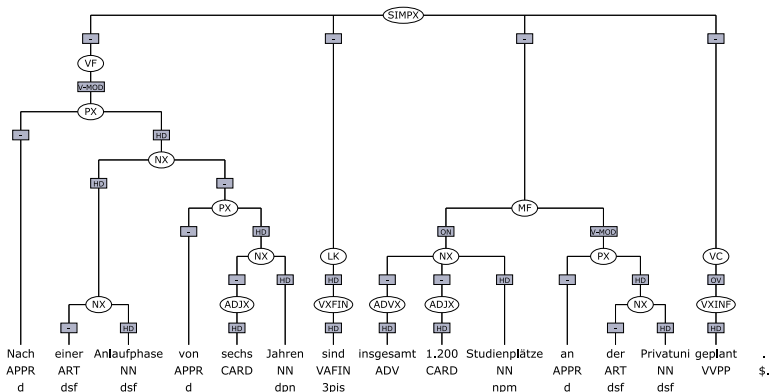
- (1) a. Der Arzt hat dem Patienten die Pille gegeben.

- b. Der Arzt hat die Pille dem Patienten gegeben.
- c. Dem Patienten hat der Arzt die Pille gegeben.
- d. Dem Patienten hat die Pille der Arzt gegeben.
- e. Die Pille hat der Arzt dem Patienten gegeben.
- f. Die Pille hat dem Patienten der Arzt gegeben.

A TIGER Sentence



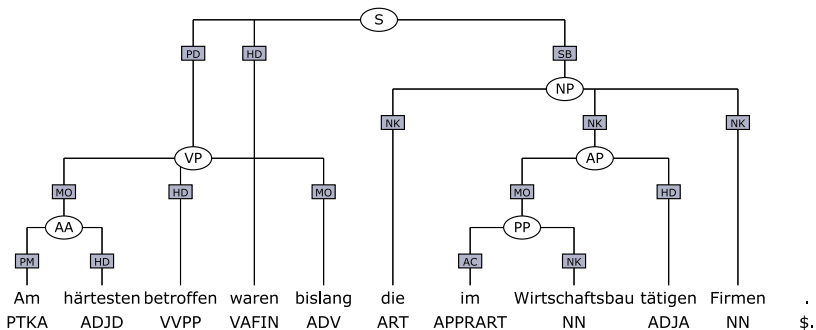
Concerning his personal future, Siemens-Boss Karlheinz Kaske is unwilling to say much.

A TüBa-D/Z Sentence



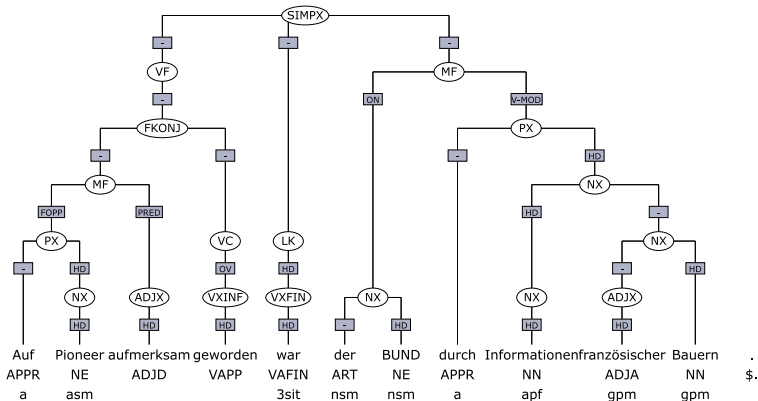
After a start-up phase of 6 years, 1,200 students are planned at the private university.

TIGER Fronting



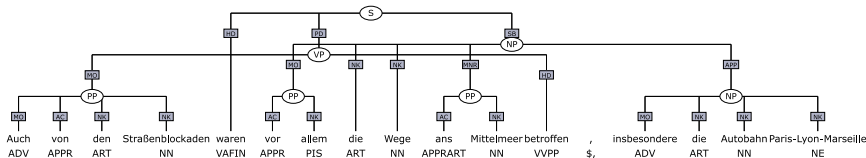
Worst affected are the companies in the commercial construction sector.

TüBa-D/Z Fronting



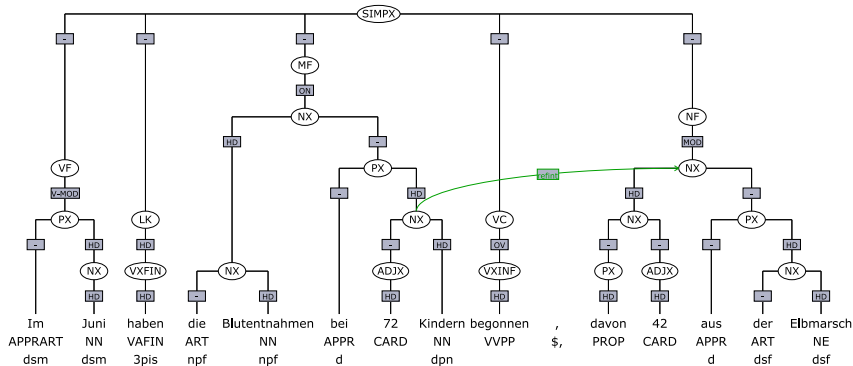
The BUND was made aware of Pioneer by information from French farmers.

TIGER Extraposition



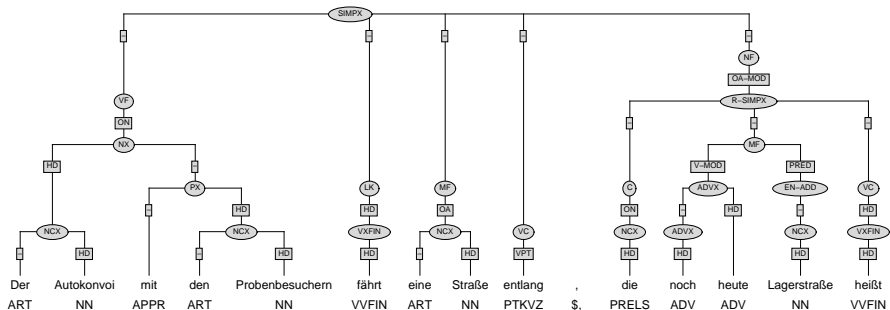
By the road blockades, especially the routes to the Mediterranean were affected, in particular the Paris-Lyon-Marseille highway.
