person, a belief in a just world can lead us to assume that the person played at least some role in bringing the event about, thereby protecting ourselves from the belief that the same event could befall us. Perhaps women who endorse items on the Rape Myths scale do so as a means of reducing their own perceived vulnerability to this often random act of violence.
