## QUESTIONS FOR DICKEN'S GLOBAL SHIFT, CHAPTER TWO

QUESTION SET 1 (Everyone)

Briefly compare the growth rates of world GDP, exports, and FDI during the late 20<sup>th</sup> century.

What might explain the *differences in the growth rates* of these flows of (a) national GDP: money within national economies, (b) exports: goods and services across national economies, and (c) FDI: capital investment among national economies?

In what countries or regions of the world has manufacturing production been growing most rapidly?

What are the world's 5 largest national exporters of merchandise (also called "goods," including raw materials, manufactures, and agricultural products)?

What are the world's 5 largest national importers of merchandise (also called "goods," including raw materials, manufactures, and agricultural products)?

What 2-3 countries seem to have the largest international-trade deficits in merchandise trade?

What 2-3 countries seem to have the largest international-trade surpluses in merchandise trade?

QUESTION SET 3 (Students drawing number 2: last name starts with H-K)

What are the world's 5 largest national producers of marketed services?

In what countries or regions of the world has services production been growing most rapidly?

What are the world's 5 largest national exporters of services?

What are the world's 5 largest national importers of services?

What 2-3 countries seem to have the largest international-trade surpluses in services trade?
