# Hall Health

Hall Health is a member of the University of Washington Physicians Primary Care Network and is a preferred provider for many health insurance plans. An outpatient clinic, Hall Health offers care to University of Washington students, faculty, staff and to the general public.

## Location.

Hall Health Primary Care Center is located at 315 East Stevens Circle on the main campus of the University of Washington. The Hall Health building can be found across from the Husky Union Building (HUB) between Padelford Hall and the University of Washington Club

#### Hours.

Hall Health Primary Care Center is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, except Tuesdays when they are open from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm.

# **Information for Non-Students**

All non-student patients are charged a fee for service. The Hall Health will directly bill your insurance plan whenever possible. All patients are responsible for co-payments and non-covered services. Consult your benefits plan for covered and non-covered services.

Non-students who do not have insurance will be asked to provide a \$75.00 deposit prior to treatment. This may or may not cover the total cost of the visit.

#### **Your First Visit**

First-time patients may register and make an appointment at Hall Health Center by calling 206-616-2495. You may also register and make an appointment in person at the Patient Services Center on the main floor of the facility. Please cancel appointments by calling the Patient Services Center at (206) 616-2495 during business hours. There is a charge for missed appointments, so please let them know in advance if you cannot be there at your arranged time.

When you come for your first visit, plan to arrive 15 minutes early to complete the registration process. Nonstudents who have no insurance coverage are asked to provide a \$50.00 deposit prior to their visits.

When you enter Hall Health Center at the main entrance (on the 1st floor), the Patient Services Center (registration and check-in) will be directly ahead. All patients must check in at the Patient Services Center for every visit. After checking in, please proceed to the waiting area of your particular clinic.
