

the workshop access and directions

Venue: Studio 267, Dance Program, University of Washington, Seattle Campus.
The program is housed on the upper level of Meany Hall.

General Directions: Meany Hall is the major performance hall for campus and visiting artists.

Nearest Street Address: Intersection of Ne 40 Street / 15th Ave Ne, Seattle WA 98195.

Access to Studio 267 Entrance 7 at the bottom of George Washington Lane (see map) is the only ramped entrance to Meany Hall providing access to the dance studios. Up the ramp there is a 37.5" power-assisted door. There will also be staff present at this entrance between 5.30 and 6.00 to facilitate access. Once you enter the building you are on the lower level (LL) of Meany. To get to the dance studios follow the corridor to the elevator at the other end. Press UL for upper level, the entrance for studio 267 is down the corridor to the left of the elevator.

Drop off: Use Gate 5 at the intersection Ne 45 Street / 15th Ave NE, (see map below). Follow the road straight ahead to the Johnson Circle to drop off. This is the closest you can get to entrance 7. Be aware that there is a ramp from the road up to entrance 7 and we can provide assistance.

Parking: The Central Plaza Garage is the closest and has accessible parking stalls Enter Gate 1 off 15th Ave NE. Ask the attendant for accessible parking on level C2 near the Henry Art Gallery elevator. Once parked take the elevator (10 on map) one level up and follow George Washington Lane down the hill to the right to entrance 7. Again this is a steep incline and we are happy to provide assistance.

There is also public roadside parking in the streets around the University (University Way, Brooklyn Ave etc.). City of Seattle parking areas are free with a valid disabled parking badge.

Restrooms: There is an ADA approved restroom on the upper level in the Dance Program.
