

Access and Directions

Venue: Studios 265-267, Dance Program, University of Washington, Seattle Campus.
The program is housed on the upper level of Meany Hall.

General Directions: Meany Hall is the major performance hall for campus and visiting artists.

Nearest Street Address: Intersection of Ne 40 Street / 15th Ave Ne, Seattle WA 98195.

Access to Studio 267 Entrance 7 at the bottom of George Washington Lane (see map) is the only ramped entrance to Meany Hall providing access to the dance studios. Up the ramp there is a 37.5" power-assisted door. This is also where the nearest UW Dial-A-Ride (Disabled Persons Shuttle) is located and an evening time wheelchair parking lot.

Once you enter the building you are on the lower level (LL) of Meany. To get to the dance studios follow the corridor to the elevator at the other end. Press (UL) for upper level. All the studios are located along the South side you are facing. All the offices and the bathrooms are to the left as you exit the elevator.

Drop off: Use Gate 5 at the intersection of Ne 45 Street and 15th Ave NE, (see map below). Immediately after the gate turn left into George Washington Lane and then right again, up the ramp towards the big red brick building (Meany Hall). This is where the Dial-A-Ride stop is located, which can be used for a drop off.

Parking: The Central Plaza Garage is the closest and has accessible parking. Enter Gate 1 off 15th Ave NE. Ask the attendant for accessible parking on level C2 near the Henry Art Gallery elevator. Once parked take the elevator (10 on map) one level up and follow George Washington Lane down the hill to the right to entrance 7. Be aware the hill is steep and. Alternatively you can also book a Dial-A-Ride shuttle to get to the accessible entrance.

There is also public roadside parking in the streets around the University (University Way, Brooklyn Ave etc.). City of Seattle parking areas are free with a valid disabled parking badge.

Restrooms: There is an ADA approved restroom on the upper level in the Dance Program.
