2. Attach a copy of your complete college transcript (UW students: unofficial transcript is acceptable.) and personal statement (see below).
3. Attach a check for \$100, payable to University of Washington. This application fee is NOT refunded if the student withdraws after having been accepted into the program.

5. Request letters of recommendation from two professors who know you well (one must be from a college level Spanish instructor). Have these letters sent to above address or to your campus coordinator.
