

Graduate Fellowships in Southeast Asian Archaeology University of Washington

Fellowship Description:

These fellowships, funded in part by the Henry Luce Foundation, are open to incoming graduate students who plan to study the archaeology of Southeast Asia. Funding includes three years of tuition, stipend and benefits. Awardees will also have opportunities to participate in summer field projects in Southeast Asia and are eligible to apply for pilot research funding in the summer of their second or third year. One Fellowship will be awarded each year.

Application Procedures:

Applicants should submit a standard application to the UW Graduate Archaeology Program and discuss their research interests in Southeast Asian archaeology in their Statement of Purpose. Archaeology Program faculty will select awardees based on the strength of their overall application.

Application Deadline:

December 15, 2009; non-US applicants should begin the application process by November 1, 2009
