## Display Model Requirements

Spend some time thinking about, working with, and making your model for the origami project. That one piece will determine 40% of your overall origami project grade! Minimally your display model must:

- 1. be turned in by the end of class (by 12:25pm) on 3/9
- 2. match the pattern you turn in on 3/16
- 3. span at least 9 inches across

Given that the model will be graded for creativity and color choice, you should spend some time choosing your medium. You might consider paper from art stores, wrapping paper, or another medium all together (remember your peers will be grading you on creativity).

Recall that your model will also be graded on 'neatness'. You should not expect your first attempts to fold your pattern to go perfectly. You may have to *practice* your pattern a few times before you can make a display model with the appropriate level of quality.
