## Group Member Assessment

Recall that one fourth of the marks for the written discussion portion of Project 2 is determined by the group members.

Each member of the group will turn in the following form where they can distribute the "Total" points available in a manner that they deem fair and reflective of the group dynamic that they experienced.

## Detailed Instructions

1) Specify the members of your group below. (Including yourself.)
2) Count up the number of people in each group (call it $n$ ) and multiply by 18.

This will be the "Total" points that you can assign.
3) For each member, indicate
a) your perceived level of involvement on a scale between 0 and 9*n
b) your perceived level of contributions on scale between 0 and $9^{*} n$

## Details about the range of numbers to assign:

Each member's points must be an integer greater than 0.
Members may grant point values over 10 if they think it is fitting.
If evenly divided, each member would earn 9 points in each category.
It is possible for a member to be very involved (e.g. attend all meetings and work with the group) but not contribute any answers. Similarly, it is possible that a member may not be involved but have answers. Names of Group Members: Involvement Contributions
