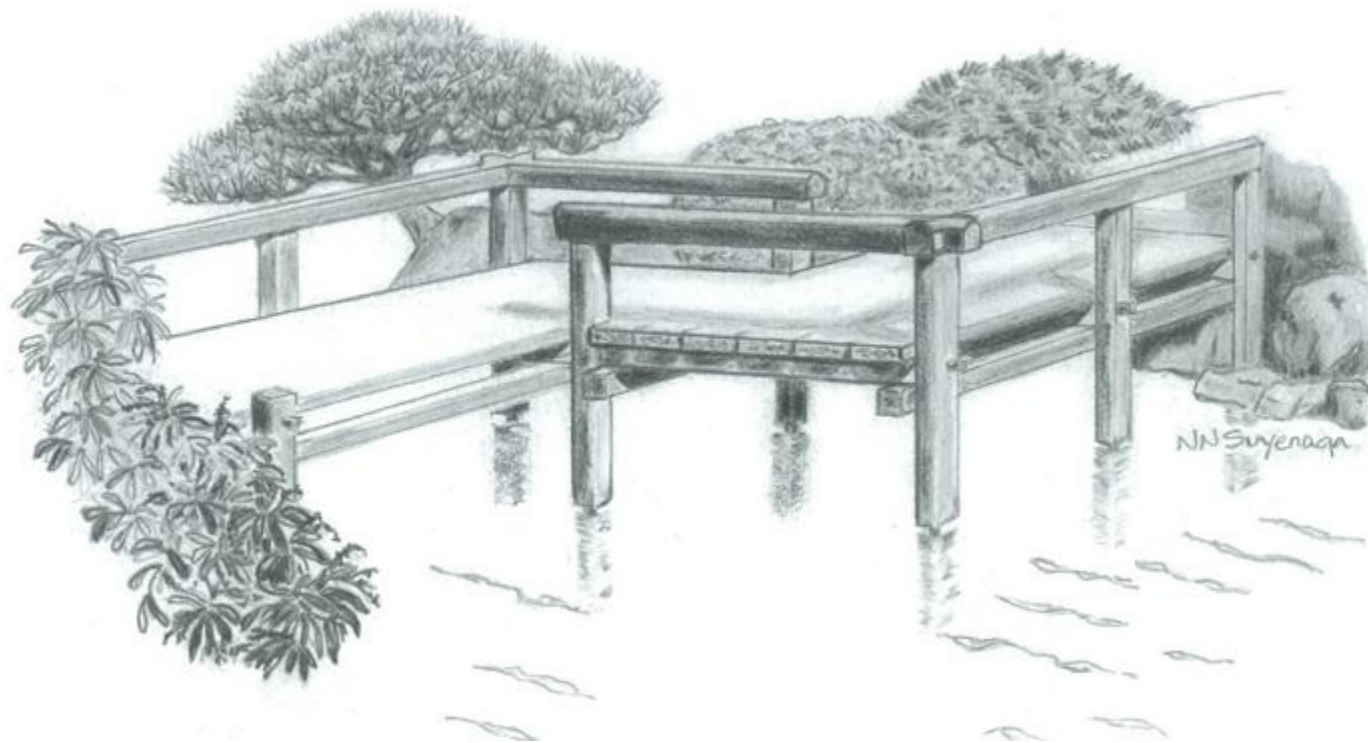

Acknowledgments

The SJG Plant Committee thanks our Seattle Parks and Recreation gardeners and staff for their dedication to the garden. This last year was one of change. Senior Gardener Pete Putnicki moved on to pursue his Landscape business. We congratulate Andrea Gillespie on her promotion to be our new Senior Gardener! We dedicate this Acknowledgment to Pete for his outstanding contribution to the garden over many years.

Pete Putnicki describes himself as a garden maker specializing in Japanese aesthetics and techniques—with skilled hands, a keen eye, and fine pruning. He emphasized these design principles:

- TSUBONIWA (The gardens of enclosed spaces. Emphasis on elegant simplicity over extravagance, also functional as part of passive climate control.)
- GAKI (Fences and walls. Celebrating the shared spaces and boundaries, the transitions between the inner and outer experience.)
- SPECIMEN PLANTING (Focus on quality over quantity, telling a complex story with clarity, grace, and sincerity.)
- FUZEI (Atmosphere or mood. Composition with space, light, and shadow, room to explore complex thoughts and feelings.)

Pete reveals this philosophy in his own words: “[Seattle Japanese Garden] is a single stroll garden with a few different ecological regions within it: mountainous areas, soft hills, and an open meadow. Yet it’s all still designed as one single uniform garden. It was built in 1960, a designer from Tokyo who was brought over and originally designed the garden sight unseen, just on paper, based on what they know about the land. As the landscape was built, it featured adaptation as a design concept. They worked to fit it into the space, rather than carving a big hole and then putting a garden in it.” Pete joined the SJG as the Senior Gardener in 2015 embracing this tradition wholeheartedly. He came to see the garden from the point of view of visitors: how to make visitors feel integrated into the space; how to direct path edges to more clearly define them; how to prune a tree to reveal view while concealing other views. He moved benches slightly off to the side of the path to help people feel they were enclosed by the garden.

Last year, he described the gardener’s role: “A gardener’s job is to create something that looks more natural than nature. Take pruning, for instance, we show off the tree’s branch structure to see the familiar softness and greenness of late spring and summer. But come wintertime, you see contrasting melancholy in the bare branch, the structure that used to hold those leaves. The gardener is tasked with making things look older, bigger, and farther away, as if elements have always been there. This helps visitors experience a sense of occupying a small space within a large yet finite timeline”.

He honored the original design of Iida, through adaptation of a mature 60-year-old garden. Maintenance is not preservation, but change that is the best possible way to honor the designer’s original intent. Gardens are always evolving, innovating in ways that are consonant with and even enhance the designer’s original intent.

THE JAPANESE GARDEN

Seattle, Washington

Welcome to the Seattle Japanese Garden in the Washington Park Arboretum. Thank you for supporting the garden through your visit. It lists the garden's plants as of 2025, and was created to increase your knowledge and enjoyment of your visit. The plant collection changes during the year, so this booklet is updated annually to reflect those changes.

How to use this Plant Booklet:

The garden is divided into 28 areas that are assigned letters of the alphabet. These areas are shown on the Garden Map on the back cover. The booklet contains three lists:

1. Detailed Plant List by Area - lists the plants within each area of the garden. In Areas A – Z, plants are listed alphabetically by Genus (specifically, by their full scientific/botanical name). In Areas ZZE & ZZW, they're listed by their location as you walk through the area. Refer to the Garden Map and this list when you see a plant that you'd like to identify. This list contains description and location information that will help you determine the correct plant, identified by its scientific name. Many of the plants have been photographed and are included in the SJG Bloom Blog -- <http://sigbloom2012.wordpress.com>. The Seattle Japanese Garden Plant List Booklet is updated annually and is available at <http://seattlejapanesegarden.org/resources>.
2. Summary Alphabetical List with Location Information – a list of plants by scientific name that lists all garden areas where each plant is located. Refer to this when you know a plant's Genus and want to find it in the garden.
3. Summary Genus List with Japanese Words – a list of plants by scientific name that provides information on Japanese naming – specifically, Japanese Syllable, Japanese Name and English Transliteration.

Seattle Parks and Recreation manages and maintains the Seattle Japanese Garden and its plant collection, in partnership with the Arboretum Foundation and the Prentice Bloedel Arboretum Unit 86.

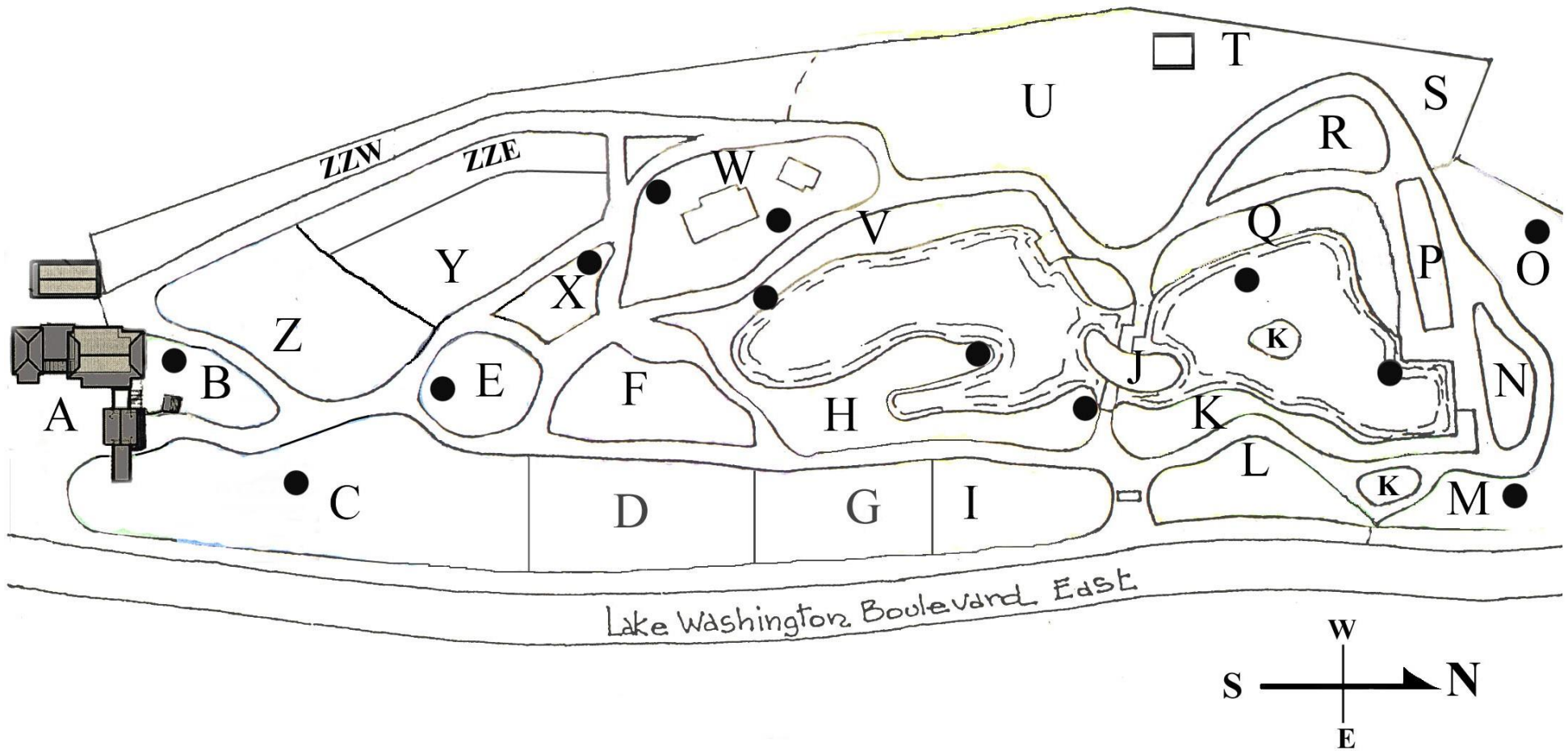
