Students enrolled in an introductory sociology course were offered one free point on a mid-term in return for writing a number between 1 and 50 on the first page of their exam. The modal answer was 25 , though numbers ending in 7 were definitely attractors. Five students ( $3 \%$ ) chose 37 , which is slightly above the expected value but within the $95 \%$ confidence interval. Perhaps most amazingly, of the 181 students who took the exam 22 (12\%) left the question blank.
