- Slide 3. Summarize your research objective(s) what design tradeoffs did you investigate?
 - (e.g. service composition, application flow control, alternate back-end relational databases)
- Slide 4. Describe your testing approach use of sequential, parallel, clients, HW description, etc.
- Slide 5. Performance evaluation results (tables / graphs) of alternate implementations I
- Slide 6. Performance evaluation results (tables / graphs) of alternate implementations II
- Slide 7. Throughput Results (tables / graphs) for alternate implementations
- Slide 8. Hosting Cost Evaluation for alternate implementations
- Slide 9. Conclusions

For the "ETL" pipeline application, throughput results describes the measured throughput of your pipeline using different sized input files (10, 100, 1000, 10000, 100000 rows, etc.) Which input datafiles allowed the best throughput?
