Objective

For the term project presentation, please prepare a 5-6 minute in-class "lightning" presentation. Lightning presentations are meant to present the "highlights" of your term project in an abbreviated format. Your presentation *could* consist of the following slides:

- Slide 1. Introduce the Group's case study application developed in Fall 2019:
 - What is the application?
 - What is the case study? (what was compared?)
- Slide 2. Describe major details regarding your application implementation (e.g. languages, tools, technologies)
- Slide 3. Describe your testing approach use of sequential, parallel, clients, HW description (ec2 instance, laptop, etc.) What is unique about how you performed testing? How was SAAF employed?
- Slide 4. Performance Comparison (pipeline runtime) results (tables / graphs)
- Slide 5. Processing Throughput Comparison (rows/second) (tables / graphs)
- Slide 6. Hosting Cost Comparison (optional, if available at time of presentation)

For the "TLQ" pipeline application, throughput describes the measured number of rows processed per second by your pipeline using different sized input files (e.g. 10, 100, 1000, 10000, 100000 rows, etc.) Which input datafile allowed the best throughput?

It is not recommended to have more than 5-6 slides.

Presentations should last approximately 5 to 6 minutes. Approximately 1 to 2 minutes will be available for questions. After 8 minutes groups will be asked to conclude their presentation and yield to the next group.
