



- Students create digital images about their jobs, being in debt and the current economic crisis. They look at the effect of globalization on their lives, and develop culture jams and narrative works. For the several years the students' posters have been displayed publicly in various venues in Seattle and have been sponsored by the WA State Labor Council.
- Another project, sometimes called "The Black Box" looks at the journey of an everyday object or commodity like coffee, cell phones or clothing. Students research the effects of that particular industry on the workers and the ecosystem and develop their research into a collaborative art project
- Our final project is to create a mask, puppet or costume that relates to global justice issues and to perform the latter on campus.




Collaborative "Black Box" project (interactive game) looking at sex toy industry






