Personal pronouns: ja, ty, on, ona, ono, my, wy, oni, one

• like nouns, can stand alone in the sentence: Ona jest dobra.

• refer back to previously mentioned nouns: Janek to jest student. On jest mlody.

• *on, ona* mean "he, she", but they also all mean "it" when they refer back to inanimate masculine and feminine nouns respectively:

To jest tulipan. On jest czerwony. To jest podłoga. Ona jest nowa. To jest okno. Ono jest duże.

Demonstrative pronouns: ten, ta, to

• like adjectives- must modify a noun and cannot stand alone in the sentence ten stół, ta lampa, to okno

• to also occurs in the expression to jest: To jest lampa. To jest stół. To jest okno.

1. This is a dog. Is it nice? Is this dog nice? This dog is nice.

2. This is a purse. It is blue. This purse is blue

3. This is a chair. Where is it? Where is this chair?

4. This is a necklace. It is red. This necklace is red.

5. This is a cat. It is black. This cat is black.

6. This is a tape. Where is it? Where is this tape? 7. This is wine. Is it good? Is this wine good?

8. This is a car. It is green. This car is green.

9. This is a picture. Is it pretty? Is this picture pretty?

10. This is a shoe. It is brown. Is this shoe brown?

11. This is a rose. Where is it? Where is this rose?

12. This is a frog. It is yellow. This frog is yellow.
